## Recognised Prior Learning

Incident and Search Management OR Specialist Rescue Incident Management OR equivalent course with comparable learning outcomes
(5082EXQ OR 5083EXQ subject to meeting criteria)
20 Credits

To enrol free of charge see Amy at the Outreach Rescue office before the end of your course
$\Rightarrow$ Each module includes coursework confirming workplace-based application of learning
$\Rightarrow \quad$ You'll have 10 weeks from the end of each course to complete the associated coursework per module ( 10 weeks starts from the end of assessment for instructor courses)
$\Rightarrow \quad$ The practical training must take place as a residential at Outreach Rescue
$\Rightarrow \quad$ Credits can only be claimed on courses you attend once enrolled, previous achievements cannot be backdated, but can be re-sat in their entirety if required
$\Rightarrow \quad$ There is an option of collecting 40 credits to achieve a Certificate in Specialist Rescue too (no RPL can be used for the certificate)
$\Rightarrow$ Diploma / Certificate must be completed within 4 years of enrolment
$\Rightarrow$ High achieving students may be invited to progress onto the Disaster and Emergency Management BSc, or even an MSc
