

DEFRA Mod4 Water & Flood Rescue Boat Operator Recertification (2 day or 3 day course)

WHICH COURSE? -

3 DAY COURSE-

Those who have maintained competency using internal or peer led CPD need to complete a minimum of 18 hrs re-certification over 3 days

2 DAY COURSE-

Those who have completed an annual CPD event of 6 hrs min with at least 4 hrs in class 2 water, delivered by Mod 4 instructor need to complete 12 hrs over 2 days

Who should attend?

Emergency Services personnel using powered craft.

Course/Programme Requirements

- Students must have a current Mod 3 and RYA 2.
 - Be fit for full operational duties in accordance with requirements for this role.
 - Have received formal training in Health and Safety at Work, including manual handling.
- (The module will involve students undertaking potentially strenuous training in and out of water).

Personal equipment should include appropriate all-weather outdoor clothing. All specialist equipment required is provided. Service uniform is not required

Aim

To recertify technicians ensuring that they can safely and effectively use powered boats and associated equipment in inland waters and flooding, by day or night, in a wide range of water conditions.

OUTCOMES- (as detailed in the mod 4 info)

Demonstrate ability to perform skills gained on RYA2 National Powerboat Course

Demonstrate boat handling in swift water

Paddle boat handling

Search and rescue operations from powered craft

Delivery Method

Practical exercises and scenarios.
A course manual is issued.

Assessment/Certification/Accreditation

Continuous assessment: results are centrally recorded and entered in a personal Record of Performance.

Students will receive Outreach Rescue Certification on successful completion of the course.

This Recertification is recommended every 3 years in order to comply with the 2020 DEFRA module 4 guidelines.
