

# Water & Flood Incident Manager

## DEFRA MOD 5 (WIM)

### Who Should Attend:

---

This module is for personnel who are required to advise or command at water and flood incidents at a tactical or operational level.

### Pre-Requisites or APL:

---

- ✦ In-date MOD 2 **OR** MOD 3 compliant award

### Requirements:

---

- ✦ Beneficial to have access to Resilience Direct and the Met Office Hazard Manager online facilities

### Aim:

---

To train incident commanders to identify, select, develop and manage appropriate tactical and operational plans in water and flood environments.

### Outcomes:

---

After successful completion of the course, the student will have a firm foundation of knowledge and should be able to meet the learning outcomes within the DEFRA Flood Rescue Concept of Operations for training Module 5.

### Compliance:

- ✦ DEFRA Module 5

### Duration:

---

4 days with 30 hours contact time

### Ratios:

Trainers 1:12 Students

### Delivery Method:

---

This course has on-line training material, including pre-course reading and a knowledge confirmation test which is part of the overall assessment process. Training is delivered through classroom lectures, presentations and table-top exercises. The course utilises recent case studies and full training notes are issued.

### Equipment:

This course is predominantly classroom-based and no specialist equipment is required. It is advised to bring a laptop.

### Assessment:

---

Course content is assessed by means of an issued workbook, a written assessment and personal reflection throughout the course. Individual feedback is provided.

### Certification:

---

Students will receive a digital Outreach Rescue certificate of achievement upon meeting assessment criteria. Results are recorded on a personal record of performance and recorded on the Outreach Rescue Database.

Certification is valid for 3 years.

### Progression:

---

Reassessment is recommended every 3 years.

This course satisfies module 'Water Incident Manager (5088EXQ)' for the Diploma in Specialist Rescue and is worth 30 credits.
