

Water Rescue Technician Mod 3

Who Should Attend:

Emergency Services personnel and personnel from organisations involved with water responses at Water and Flood Rescue Technician (DEFRA Mod 3) level.

Pre-Requisites or APL:

- ✧ Stand-alone module with no pre-requisites

Requirements:

- ✧ Indicated aptitude for working in and on water
- ✧ Fit for operational duties
- ✧ Ability to swim

Aim:

To train responders to identify their limitations and safely and effectively use appropriate water rescue equipment, whilst operating near, on, or in moving water.

Outcomes:

- ✧ Demonstrate water rescue scene management and dynamic assessment of risk
- ✧ Identify and apply the role of the mod 3 within the incident management structure
- ✧ Identify and apply a working knowledge of water related hazards and their rescue implications
- ✧ Have an understanding of search procedures
- ✧ Identify and use PPE
- ✧ Demonstrate swimming and manoeuvring in moving (class2) water
- ✧ Demonstrate quick-release drills
- ✧ Understand and apply relevant rescue techniques
- ✧ Have a working knowledge of basic boat handling by paddle and rope systems
- ✧ Demonstrate rigging and operating rope systems
- ✧ Have a working knowledge of specialist rescue equipment (where in use by organisation)
- ✧ Demonstrate techniques for movement in shallow water
- ✧ Demo casualty management issues specific to the water environment

Compliance:

- ✧ DEFRA Mod 3
- ✧ NFCC Rescue Boat Code Mod 3

Duration:

5 days with 37 hours contact time

Ratios:

Trainers 2:7 Students

Delivery Method:

Lectures, classroom work, practical sessions and scenario based training. A course manual is issued.

Equipment:

Specialist equipment and PPE is included. You can provide your own PPE provided it is serviceable subject to inspection by our trainers.

Assessment:

Course content is assessed by a combination of direct observations of set tasks, question and answer, written/multi choice exams and scenario-based assessment. Individual feedback is provided.

Certification:

Students will receive a digital Outreach Rescue certificate of achievement upon meeting assessment criteria. Results are recorded on a personal record of performance and recorded on the Outreach Rescue Database.

Certification is valid for 3 years.

Progression:

Reassessment & Refresher training is recommended every 2 years.

- ✧ Defra Team Commander
- ✧ DEFRA Mod 5
